

Cheat Sheet

For cleaning/sanitizing your Fountain Dispenser

Tools Needed



K5 Sanitizer



Safety Goggles



Spray Bottle



Bristle Brush



Sanitary Gloves



Clean Rag

Removing and cleaning nozzles and diffusers

Take the nozzle and quarter turn it to the left to unlock it, then pull it straight down. For the diffuser, pull straight out. Add them to warm soapy water and use the bristle brush to clean out build up and debris. Rinse both the nozzle and diffuser under running water to remove any soap residue. Fill a container with sanitizing solution (warm water & K5) and add the nozzle and diffuser. Soak for 15 minutes. Remove and air dry on clean rag. [Video](#) & [Video](#)

Cleaning/ Sanitizing Dispenser

Take a clean rag dampened with soapy water. Starting from the top, wipe down the dispenser to remove any dirt or residue. Pay special attention to the valve covers, ensuring thorough cleaning, especially beneath the valves where syrup and buildup accumulate. Wipe down the splash plate and ensure it is clean all around, as well as the drain tray. If applicable, remove the drain grates for washing, either by hand or in a dishwasher. Pour hot water down the drain to clear any debris, then rinse it out. Move on to sanitizing by spraying surfaces with a sanitizing solution from a spray bottle, ensuring thorough coverage. Let it sit and air dry. Optionally, pour some sanitizing solution into the drain to sanitize it as well. [Video](#)
